

Analysis of Social Deixis in the Movie Full Metal Jacket (1987)

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Abstract

This research deals with the implementation of social deixis in the movie Full Metal Jacket (1987). It aims to find out the kinds of social deixis and to explain the social relationship between the characters utterances in the movie Full Metal Jacket (1987) which contains social deixis. This research using descriptive qualitative method and implementing purposive sampling data collection techniques. As the result, the researcher found two kinds of social deixis such as relational social deixis and absolute social deixis. In this research also found that relational social deixis used more dominant by the character in the movie Full Metal Jacket (1987) than the absolute social deixis.

Analisis Deiksis Sosial di Film Full Metal Jacket (1987)

Abstrak

Penelitian ini membahas tentang implementasi deiksis sosial di film Full Metal Jacket (1987). Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui jenis-jenis deiksis sosial dan untuk menjelaskan hubungan sosial antar tuturan pemeran di dalam film Full Metal Jacket (1987) yang mengandung deiksis sosial. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif dan menerapkan teknik pengumpulan data purposive sampling. Hasilnya, peneliti menemukan dua jenis deiksis sosial yaitu deiksis sosial relasional dan deiksis sosial absolut. Di dalam penelitian ini juga ditemukan bahwa deiksis sosial relasional lebih dominan digunakan oleh tokoh dalam film Full Metal Jacket (1987) dibandingkan deiksis sosial absolut.

1. Introduction

It is commonly known that impossible human being existence are inseparable from numbers of fundamental elements that inadvertently present in it. Eat, drink, breath, interact with each other are examples of basic things that almost every person on this earth does every day. In interacting, of course, humans are very dependent on communication tools ranging from basic to renewable, for example language. From the perspective of science, communication defined as a process of delivering message or information from one individual, as a speaker, to another as the listener, and works the opposite way. Language is an application that becomes a medium for humans to communicate and interact with each other through random verbal-auditory symbols. (Lyons 1981:4). It is the most basic tool for communication that being used since the beginning of the human being history. There are many languages that have been identified throughout human civilization for

thousands of years. For example, English, Indonesia, Java, Tagalog, Russian, and still many more that spread out in every land and country in the world.

In language, there are many aspects and branches of knowledge that specified and detailing all information about the language itself. In English, there are four basic skills of language such as Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing. In speaking, Linguistic, Pragmatic, deixis, etc, are identified as a branch of knowledge that detailing the major basic skills in it. This is what causes the diversity of language forms in society. This research discusses about deixis, precisely about social deixis that appeared in the movie Full Metal Jacket (1987). Deixis is an advanced way to explain the relationship between language and context in the structure of the language itself. Words like I, now and here, are examples of words that implementing deixis. These words do not have a fixed reference, so when referring to the words I, now, and here, you can know the meaning if you also know who, time and place the words were said. So, the center of orientation deixis is native. Deixis is widespread in language, which then becomes one of the factors in indicating where, when, who, what, and so on, it is so useful to start with the coordinates of the speech situation field. (Griffiths, 2006). There are several common sentences or words in our respective languages that are difficult to interpret if the main context of the word or sentence is not completely known to determine the physical context of the speaker (Yule, 2006). These are words such as there and here, that or this, then and now, yesterday, today, or tomorrow, as well as pronouns such as me, you, she, her, it, them, etc. In deixis theory, there are categories of deixis that classified the deixis into more detail classification such as person deixis, place deixis, time deixis, discourse deixis, and social deixis. From all categories of deixis that researcher had mentioned, the researcher uses and focuses the research in the social deixis more.

The research focuses in analysing the social deixis expressions found and identified in the movie Full Metal Jacket (1987), and it also explain the kinds of relation in the use of social deixis in the movie Full Metal Jacket (1987). This research uses the deixis theory proposed by Levinson, because it provided complete social deixis analysis such as social identity in marking people, speech levels, names, titles, kinship, insults, greeting and expressions of gratitude according to the relationship between speaker and listener. This theory can also be used to analyse the movie that being used by the researcher. Intending to identify the kinds of social deixis used in the movie Full Metal Jacket (1987), the social influences, existence of social deixis, and social deixis are the most dominant in the movie Full Metal Jacket.

2. Literature Review

In making this research appropriate, the study that researcher do is related with other study that focuses on deixis and especially social deixis. The researcher took some related studies from several different sources. It makes researcher found various literatures that related to the formal object or the primary theory of this research. By using some of these previous studies, the researcher easily to understand the material object in the research.

The research about deixis has been conducted by several previous researchers. Some of the research that the researcher choose as a literature review are focuses on deixis which

discussed the five kinds of deixis and some are discussed about social deixis which has a related topic with this research.

The first study conducted by Maysita Halawa (2018) entitled *An Analysis of Deixis in The Article of The Jakarta Post*. The purpose of the research is to explain the use of deixis in several articles of Jakarta Post such as Person Deixis, Time Deixis, Place Deixis, Discourse Deixis, and Social Deixis, and determine how the kinds of deixis were used in the Jakarta Post. This research implementing descriptive qualitative method to analyse the data in the form of documents from political articles containing deixis used in the Jakarta post. The results of the research showed that in the article of Jakarta Post that was posted on September 19, 2017 uses Person deixis 42 times (9,43%), Place deixis 9 times (5,66%), Time deixis 15 times (9,43%), Discourse deixis 32 times (20,12%) and social deixis 61 times (38,36%). The researcher suggests for the future researcher to expand on this field by utilizing other materials, including speech, novels, and everyday conversations.

The second study comes from Andi Narda Aulia Jirani (2023), the title of the literature is *Social Deixis in The King's Man Movie: A Pragmatic Analysis*. This research aims to find and identify social deixis and social position used in the movie King's Man (2021). This research uses descriptive qualitative method with descriptive approach to gain the data by note taking in obtaining the sample needed. The researcher uses purposive sampling technique by using the movie script. The researcher makes a frame of discourse test consists of 32 dialogs as the representative information. The researcher specified the two kinds of social deixis such as relational social deixis and absolute social deixis. The result of the research indicates that the frequent kind of social deixis used by the characters in the movie is relational social deixis in form of addressee honorifics kind, in which the most used address term is the word "sir". The least used are absolute social deixis, which is used by formal speakers, and relational social deixis, which is used by speaker and setting. The researcher can establish the character social status through dialogue, in which the main character plays several roles based on his interactions with other characters, his speaking style, and when he appears in the scene.

Another research was conducted by Riski Sugiyarti (2022) entitled *Social Deixis in Four Lions Movie*. This research discusses social deixis in movie Four Lions. The concept of social deixis proposed by Fillmore utilized in this research analysis of social deixis to collect data based on the research objectives and analyse it using purposive sampling procedures, this research employs a qualitative descriptive method to ensures the results are more representative. The research findings adding notions that the movie Four Lions implement five different social deixis kinds namely individuals, differentiating speech levels, assigning names, titles, and kinship words, and different performance techniques. It is a kind of performing language that might support other social activities and be seen as a social act.

The fourth research conducted by Dwiki Prasetyo (2018). The title of the research is *Social Deixis in The Movie King Arthur: The Legend of Sword (2017)*. This research

discusses and analyse social deixis used in the movie *King Arthur: The Legend of Sword* (2017). This research is descriptive qualitative research. The researcher found 151 expressions contained social deixis which consist of relational social deixis and absolute social deixis. The finding shows the researcher found 55% of relational social deixis and 45% of absolute social deixis found in the movie *King Arthur: The Legend of Sword*. The researcher also found some social relationship such as Clan (13%), Title (32%) and Friendship (55%).

From the four of the previous study that the researcher provided above, first research is the only research that discussed deixis with the five kinds of deixis and taking data from a written literature, whether the other three researches were taken data from the movie as the primary data source. The researcher decided to choose movie as the data source because movie is a literature example that able to be the oral language of a message that conveyed during the movie scene. *Full Metal Jacket* (1987) is the movie that the researcher chooses as the primary data source because this kind of movie genre is rarely discussed in the field of linguistic with a reason that there are only frequent people who had a knowledge or specific information about the atmosphere of this kind of movie. This movie described so many things about war, military environment, conflict, drama, and visualization of War trooper bad habit during the war that normally happened by the military personal. *Full Metal Jacket* (1987) is a war drama movie that directed and produces by Stanley Kubrick which describes about the real events that occurred in Vietnam between the USA and North Vietnam that occurred in the 1955-1975 era. This movie focusses on a journey of US Marine Corps Platoon 3092, on the point of view of Sergeant Davis or known as “Joker” who was a military journalist that deployed to the Vietnam conflict after graduating from the Marine Corps recruit depot in Parris Island, South Carolina. This movie contained a lot of social deixis expressions that in the characters utterances during the play of the movie, whether relational social deixis and absolute social deixis.

The similar thing or field between the previous study and this research is in the focus of determining the use of social deixis and kinds of social deixis in several examples of literature, in this case is movie. But in this research, the researcher focuses more on how the social deixis used in the movie *Full Metal Jacket* (1987) which is a genre of movie that rarely used as the research object.

Method

This research is descriptive qualitative. Descriptive meant describe the research object or research results. The descriptive research method is used to find out a picture, situation, or something by describing it in as much detail as possible based on the facts (Tabrhonei, 2021). This method was used to discover, identify, analyse, and investigate social deixis implementation in the movie *Full Metal Jacket* (1987). It was also known as a document analysing method. According to Nazir (1998:34), qualitative methods are methods used to describe situations, events, or occurrences in data collection.

3. Finding and Discussion

After finding data of social deixis in the movie *Full Metal Jacket* (1987), the researcher found examples that divided into two kinds consist of Relational social deixis and Absolute social deixis. Based on the finding, the researcher found that the expressions of relational social deixis are used more dominant than absolute social deixis. The researcher found 24 expressions of social deixis that consist of 17 expressions of relational social deixis and 7 expressions of absolute social deixis.

3.1. Finding

Based on the research objectives, the researcher decides to analyse the social deixis in the movie *Full Metal Jacket* (1987) based on the type of social deixis and the social relationship in the use of social deixis. The researcher provided the analysis in a table to easier the understanding and make it more interesting to read.

3.1.1. Types of Social Deixis

The researcher divided the table into each type of social deixis consist of absolute and relational social deixis.

a. Absolute Social Deixis

3.1.2. Types of Social Relationship

In the movie *Full Metal Jacket* (1987), there are some social relations which classified by the researcher which explain how social deixis occurred in the movie. The researcher divided the social relation into three types such as rank, title, and nickname.

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3.2. Discussion

After finding data of social deixis in the movie *Full Metal Jacket* (1987), the researcher found examples that divided into two types consist of Relational social deixis and Absolute social deixis. Based on the finding, the researcher found that the expressions of relational social deixis are used more dominant than absolute social deixis. The researcher found 24 expressions of social deixis that consist of 17 expressions of relational social deixis and 7 expressions of absolute social deixis.

The researcher analysed 24 expressions of social deixis in the movie *Full Metal Jacket* (1987) divided into two kinds of social deixis consists of Absolute Social Deixis and Relational Social Deixis. The finding results shows that Relational Social

Deixis are used more dominant by the character in the movie *Full Metal Jacket* (1987), rather than Absolute Social Deixis.

The researcher chooses the research conducted by Dwiki Prasetyo (2018) as a reference for the previous study. This research is the continue version of the research conducted by Dwiki Prasetyo (2018), and using the same theory of deixis from Stephen C. Levinson. Although used the same theory, the result of the research has a different found. In this research, researcher found two kinds of social deixis consists of Absolute Social Deixis, and three kinds of social relationship consist of Rank, Title, and Nickname. Whether in Dwiki Prasetyo's research found the same two kinds of social deixis with three kinds of social deixis consist of Title, Clan, and Friendship.

4. Conclusion

In this chapter, the researcher draws a conclusion of the analysis based on the finding and discussion results. This research used a social deixis theory proposed by Stephen C, Levinson (1983). It contains conclusion that connected between the notion of Pragmatic and Deixis. As provided above, the researcher found examples of social deixis expressions in the movie *Full Metal Jacket* (1987) that researcher divided into two kinds consist of 17

expressions of relational social deixis and 7 expressions of absolute social deixis, totally 24 expressions. And it can be concluded, the theory proposed by Levinson (1983) is proper with this research.

Researcher found that relational social deixis expressions are used more dominant than the absolute social deixis in the movie *Full Metal Jacket* (1987). This movie visualizes a situation of Military bootcamp and the combat field or in other word is warzone, where a group of soldiers usually had a close relationship by each other and makes social deixis becomes a dominant aspect of linguistic which dominantly occur in the movie's conversation. Moreover, the researcher defines the social factors and social relationships using the speech situation context theory provided by Geoffrey Leech (1983). Furthermore, it may provide novel ideas about interpersonal communication. Lastly, social deixis is crucial for study since it can serve as a guide for middle-aged people seeking to communicate and understand social culture.

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
